### Early Years

### School Priorities and Actions

- Increase progress of children from the end of KS1 to the end of KS2 through a 3 week learning review cycle.
- Develop a mastery approach to mathematics to enable all learners to make progress within each lesson and over time.
- Ensure that children are able to use their knowledge of English, grammar and punctuation which is embedded in their writing, so that it can be applied in national tests.

- Ensure that children who are not at the national standard in one area have targeted support to raise the combined measure to the same levels as individual subjects.
- Raise writing outcomes to the same level as writing outcomes at the end of KS2.
