Dear Parents and Carers,

#### **Industrial Action**

### **Sports**

We have had some fantastic sporting success over the last few weeks with our Year 5/6 athletes coming second in the North Somerset County indoor Athletics Championships.

Our Year 5/6 boys football team won the North Somerset Championships before Christmas and will be playing in the Somerset Final in Street on Wednesday – we wish them the good fortune that their talent, teamwork and hard work deserves!

#### Curriculum

Our teachers have been sharing English and Maths work with other schools from across the Trust, moderating teacher assessment and sharing good practice. This has affirmed the strength of our teacher expertise and the high quality of the learning that your children do in school every day!

Myself, Mrs Sargent and Mr Sprake watched English lessons across the whole school this week. It was a joy to see the focus of our pupils, the high quality writing they are producing, their stamina for writing and the exemplary teaching we saw in all year groups.

I have been running maths and leadership workshops for the Boolean Maths Hubs which provides some additional funding for the school budget. As part of this work, we will be showcasing our maths practice to teachers from across the South West on March the 1<sup>st</sup>. The teaching of Maths is another school strength and Mr Capel will be working alongside Maths leaders and the Boolean Hub leaders to develop other maths leaders.

# **Mid-Year Reports**

Teachers are finalising their mid-year assessments across the Trust and our teaching staff will shortly begin preparing mid-year school reports for you. These will be sent out to you on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> of February.

We have been working with school staff, our school council and our anti-bullying ambassadors as we finalise our new behaviour policy and update our school routines, rewards and sanctions.
