Key Stage One Cycle Improvers Workshop starting November!
Back by popular demand, we've teamed up with Fox Cycling to continue running a **weekly after-school cycling workshop, Cycle Improvers**, for our Key Stage 1 children, starting November 2024.

CYCLE IMPROVERS:

Pedal Bike Workshop *(for those who can already ride a pedal bike without stabilisers)*



For those children who are cycling (without stabilisers), Fox Cycling will run Cycle Improvers. Cycle Improvers is a confidence-builder course, offering the chance for children to further develop their abilities on a pedal bike. Through fun games and challenges, children will advance their cycling skills in balance, safe and effective braking, advanced cornering, glancing behind them, lifting a hand off the handlebars etc.

If your child can already ride a pedal bike without stabilisers, and would like to take part in Cycle Improvers, we ask that you **please supply your child's bike and helmet for the sessions**. If your child does not have a helmet or a bike, please let us know and Fox Cycling can help you.

What does it cost?

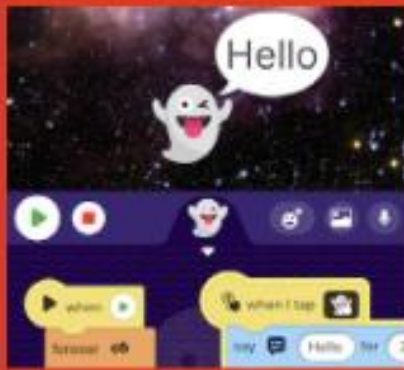
